Data Note 1: Not connected means person does not have a monthly cell phone or internet subscription or does not have the technology to connect.

Data Note 2: R1 or R2 denotes state's rural level. The state of Massachusetts' definition and designation of rural levels are purposefully created for use in assessment and planning. Both levels are rural. Level two is less densely population and more remote and isolated from urban core areas. If town does not have a designation it is considered urban.
